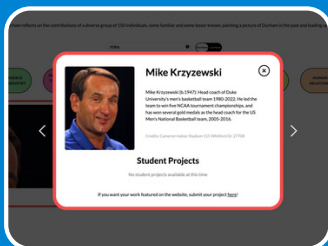
150 Faces of Durham also exists as a traveling exhibit and educational tool for local students.



Project Goal

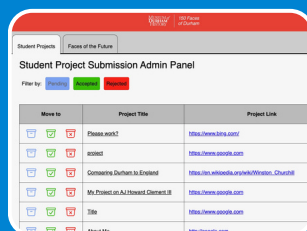

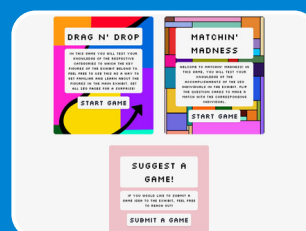
Modal View

- Carousel to display student projects



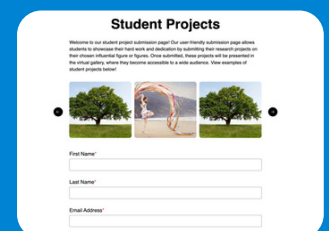
Admin Panel
